Catholic Climate Covenant inspires and equips Catholic people and institutions to work toward climate solutions. Together with our partners, Catholic Climate Covenant catalyzed real, faithinspired progress in 2015.

RAISING CATHOLIC VOICES ON CLIMATE

Catholics care about climate change. In 2015, Pope Francis inspired the world with his landmark encyclical, Laudato Si'. We were central to amplifying his message.

- We convened faith and secular stakeholders to identify critical themes and coordinate public support from key leaders.
- We conducted media trainings to prepare the U.S. bishops, key messengers of support, which helped generate statements from 110 bishops.
- We helped organize 2 press conferences at the National Press Club, and 5 additional press conferences in selected states.
- Our work was featured in 3,000+ media stories.

Raising these voices matters. Highly visible Catholic leadership encourages Catholic people and their elected representatives to act.

GROWING GRASSROOTS CAPACITY

Informing and inspiring community leaders to take action is essential to achieving the Church's vision on climate change.

- We equipped 550 local champions to lead Feast of St. Francis educational events in their parishes and communities.
- We developed resources and leadership training for 140 Creation Care Teams, which drive concrete results in their parishes.
- We helped our supporters send over 10,000 messages to public officials and others urging action on climate change.


PARTNERING FOR NATIONAL LEADERSHIP
