## **Step One: Learn**

## **Step Two: Act**

- o Use the calculator included in the <u>Plastic Pollution Primer and Action Tool Kit</u> to learn about your plastic consumption.
- o Think about the actions you can take to help by applying what you learned about the 5 Rs: Reduce, Reuse, Refuse, Recycle and Remove.
- o Create your Personal Plastic Plan and track your progress.
