WHOLEMAKERS, is a curriculum on integral ecology for use in young adult ministry contexts. It weaves together the latest climate science with insights from Catholic tradition to equip participants to be what Pope Francis calls "the protagonists of this transformation" for the world. It is developed for young adults and by young adults. The curriculum is intended to be used in high schools, college campuses, and small groups in parishes and other contexts. Wholemakers includes 10 sessions, with tracks focusing on Spirituality & Ecology, Sustainability & Simple Living, and Social Action & Civic Love.

ACCESS WHOLEMAKERS



- Year-long leadership and spiritual formation program for young adults (18-39) across the U.S. Catholic Church. This program is led by Catholic Climate Covenant in collaboration with Loyola University Chicago and Creighton University.
- Build a "culture of encounter" to catalyze "ecological conversion."
- Receive training in Catholic social teaching, Vatican Laudato Si'
 Action Platform, climate science, community organizing, and climate advocacy.

- 23 young adult leaders across 15 dioceses
- Over half come from frontline communities.
- Backgrounds include youth ministry, atmospheric science, sustainability coordination, environmental justice advocacy, urban planning, and more.
- Organize to meet with their bishop and diocesan leaders, and advocate for climate action that lives the Church's mission: enacting the Vatican's Laudato Si' Action Platform with a focus on net zero.
